2023-2024 Child Nutrition Meal Charge Policy

Dear Parent/Guardians,

Kiefer Public Schools offer their students nutritious meals at a minimal cost. Negative balances affect the operation of the lunch program to function in a responsible manner. The students are required to keep a positive balance in their lunch account. They will not be allowed to charge lunch or breakfast.

- Lunchroom payments need to be in a sealed envelope with the student's name and dollar amount on the front.
- Parents can check and pay balances online thru the Sylogist link on the school website.
- PreK to 3rd Grade students need to turn lunchroom money into their homeroom teacher.
- 4th grade to High School students need to turn lunchroom money into the front office or to the lunchroom staff.
- Notices of unpaid balances are sent home with students to parents on a weekly basis. This money should be sent to the office promptly.
- Parents are encouraged to apply for Free and Reduced Lunch/Breakfast under the federal government guidelines. Applications are available at the school or on the district website. Income is not the only criteria needed to qualify.
- Students will be treated with courtesy regardless of whether or not the parent has provided payment to the school district.
